JOB SUMMARY

Assists in the installation of conduit and electrical components into buildings. Requires basic math skills, ability to read blueprints, mechanical aptitude, and basic problem-solving ability. Performs multiple routines or semi-complex tasks with limited exercise of judgment. Performs duties under close supervision. Assists more advanced employees in mid-level work for development and training.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Bends and cuts various conduit per blueprint specification using appropriate tools.
- 2. Mounts electrical boxes, fixtures, and enclosures.
- 3. Stocks and sets up electrical wire carts.
- 4. Pulls wire through conduit and makes ground connections.
- 5. Reads blueprints to determine placement of wire.
- 6. Installs and covers receptacles and switches.
- 7. Performs other tasks as assigned by crew leader or supervisor.
