JOB SUMMARY

Responsible for maintaining and repairing mechanical equipment and machinery.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Performs repairs to plant machinery. Includes, but not limited to: forklifts, front end loaders, skid steer, backhoe, boom lifts, scissor lifts, plant vehicles, truck cranes, straddle lifts and golf carts.
- Performs repairs on plant equipment. Includes, but not limited to: rod chompers, saws, presses, welding machines, overhead hoists, pressure washers and compressors.
- Performs repairs on small pneumatic and hydraulic tools.
- Performs basic grinding, drilling, lathe, welding and other shop maintenance actions.
- Performs preventative maintenance inspections of vehicles, equipment and machinery.

NON-ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Performs other duties as required by crew leader or supervisor. This may include helping the building and grounds crews or electricians, etc.
- Basic cleaning and housekeeping duties.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 2-5 years of previous maintenance/industrial mechanic experience.
- HS diploma / GED required.
- Must pass forklift certification test.

SKILLS

- Ability to communicate effectively, both verbal and written.
- Must possess a mechanical aptitude.
- Must be familiar with belts, bearings, pulleys, chains, sprockets, etc.
- Must be familiar with most hand tools and common power tools.
- Must be knowledgeable of bearing plates and hydraulic presses.
- Must be familiar with gearboxes and speed reducers.
- Must understand the principles of "cause and affect".
- Good judgment and attention to detail.
- Ability to read, comprehend and assimilate information.
- Ability to maintain satisfactory working relationships and interact effectively with all levels of employees.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Job requires wearing personal protective equipment, such as protective eyewear and steel-toed boots. Exposed to seasonal temperatures throughout the year. Job requires ability to operate miscellaneous hand and power tools.

Job requires standing for short periods of time while working on mechanical equipment. Job requires stooping or crouching regularly when working with mechanical equipment. Also requires bending at the waist and legs when removing parts from boxes prior to installation. Requires climbing a stepladder in order to work on mechanical equipment in some places. Job requires considerable walking, going from place to place within the facility and on the premises.

Job requires ability to lift up to 20 lbs. frequently and 50 lbs. occasionally when working with mechanical equipment and tools on the job. Must be able to carry objects such as ladders or parts from warehouse.

Job requires clarity of vision, with or without corrective lenses.

Job requires working in various environments. Exposed to such hazardous conditions as extreme noise levels and electrical, automatic, and/or moving equipment.
