JOB SUMMARY

Responsible for ensuring that all materials of buildings are painted. This includes prepping and sanding. Responsible for the supervision of a paint crew. Also responsible for training new personnel in the department.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- 1. Sands, preps and cleans all materials that require painting.
- 2. Repairs any damages to materials prior to painting with Bondo, JB weld, etc.
- 3. Mixes paints as per specifications.
- 4. Paints large metal buildings, doors, miscellaneous metal parts, etc., consistently and accurately without dry streaks/runs or sags with airless sprayer/HVLP.
- 5. Supervises and directs a paint crew.
- 6. Serves as liaison between damages to materials prior to painting. paint crew and supervisor
- 7. Responsible for training new personnel and new procedures.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE

- 1. Must be highly skilled in the application of all types of paint using brush, roller, cup spray guns, pressure pot spray equipment, airless spray equipment and be able to fully use, clean and maintain all paint equipment.
- 2. Must demonstrate the ability to select the proper application method for the paint and the surface to be painted.
- 3. Must perform all work at a high quality level with minimal rejects.
- 4. Must be able to lead a crew to complete the assigned job tasks and pass QA inspections.
- 5. Completion of an industrial painting course or background in industrial painting required.
