	Person	Exposure To	Actions	Site Access Restored	Notification Required
Known Risk	Employee with COVID-19 positive test result		Self isolate at home	If employee has had symptoms , return to work after fever free for 72 hours without use of fever-reducing medicines AND improvement in respiratory symptoms AND 14 days since symptoms first appeared. If employee has had no symptoms prior to or after testing , return to work 14 days after date positive test result was received. 	Employee with a clinically compatible illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath) not yet tested for COVID-19		Self isolate at home and seek medical evaluation for testing	If COVID-19 test results are positive , return to work after 72 hours fever free without use of fever-reducing medicines AND improvement in respiratory symptoms AND 14 days since symptoms first appeared. If COVID-19 test results are negative , return to work upon receipt of test results AND fever-free for 48 hours without use of fever-reducing medicines. Increased Risk	Household member Intimate partner Providing care in a household without using recommended infection control precautions Close contact (<6 feet) for a prolonged period of time	Person with symptomatic COVID-19 (positive test result or clinically compatible illness) during period from 48 hours before symptoms onset until person meets criteria for discontinuing home isolation.	Self monitor for symptoms Wear a facial covering for 14 days after last exposure Avoid contact with people at higher risk for severe illness unless they live in the same home and had the same exposure Seek medical evaluation if symptoms develop	For employees with no symptoms, return to work with continued daily temporal scans prior to site entry, continued social distancing (>6 feet) and wearing of facial covering at all times for 14 days since last exposure. Employee must report any onset of symptoms immediately to their supervisor and refer to directives above for KNOWN risk employees. Unknown Risk	All other persons	Possible unrecognized COVID-19 exposures	Be alert for symptoms Practice social distancing (>6 feet) at all times Seek medical evaluation if symptoms develop
