

# **ELECTRICAL TECH 1**

## **JOB SUMMARY**

Entry level position. Assists in the installation of conduit and electrical components into buildings. Requires basic math skills, ability to read blueprints, mechanical aptitude and basic problem-solving ability. Performs multiple routine or semi-complex tasks with limited exercise of judgment. Performs duties under moderate supervision. Assists more advanced employees in mid-level work for development and training.

## **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- Bends and cuts various conduit per blueprint specification using appropriate tools.
- Mounts electrical boxes, fixtures and enclosures.
- Stocks and sets up electrical wire carts.
- Pulls wire through conduit and makes ground connections.
- Reads blueprints to determine placement of wire.
- Installs and covers receptacles and switches.
- Performs other tasks as assigned by crewleader or supervisor.

- Must demonstrate mechanical aptitude.
- Ability to read blueprints.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both oral and written.
